

StaRN Nurse Residency Program

HCA Florida Healthcare trains over **2500 nurse residents at 14 hospitals** each year, with 500+ hours of clinical education in the classroom and at the bedside.



Tuition reimbursement program: Up to \$5,250 per year – approx. \$40 million reimbursed nationwide



Certification support:

Pre-paid vouchers, test fee reimbursements and bonuses for achieving specific, nationally recognized clinical and other patient care certifications beyond current position requirements.

StarTech Patient Care Technician Program

HCA Florida Healthcare provides a pathway for high school graduates or second-career individuals to start healthcare careers as novice Patient Care Technicians.

Paid five-week training program: After 200 hours of classroom interactive lectures, electronic health record practice, and hands-on clinical training, graduates are ready to assist with patient care in a hospital setting.
